

Mystery Quilt 2 – Month 5

1. Take the 3½" squares of assorted prints cut in Step 1 of Month 2, the Unit B's with the accent fabric made in Month 1, and the Unit E's made in Month 3. Arrange as shown in Diagram 8. Sew in rows to make 8 (2) blocks measuring 12½" (including seam allowances). Label these Block 2.

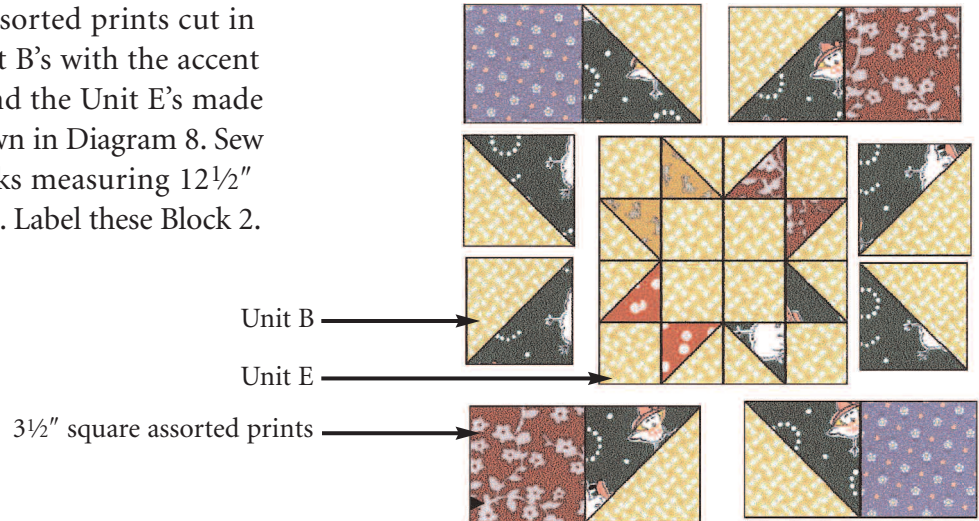
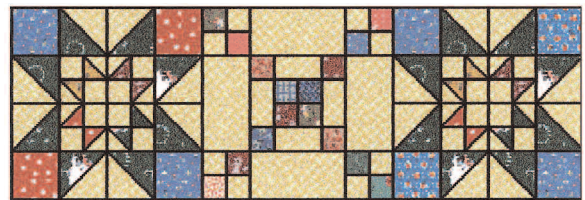


Diagram 8 – Block 2

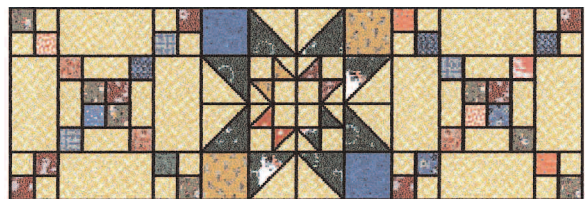
2. Arrange Block 1's from Month 3 and Block 2's into quilt center of 5 (1) rows of 3 blocks each. Alternate Block 1 and Block 2 in each row. Alternate Block 1 and Block 2 in each row.

Row 1, Row 3, Row 5 for Quilt

Row 1 for Table Runner



Row 2, Row 4 for Quilt only



3. **For Quilt only:** Add the borders made in Month 4 to complete your quilt top, turning them so that the pieced rectangular blocks (Month 4, Diagram 7) are adjacent to Block 2's, and the background rectangles are next to Block 1's, completing the chains. Sew side borders first.
- 3a. **For Table Runner only.** Add the borders made in Month 4 to complete the table runner, sewing side borders on first.
4. This completes Mystery Quilt 2; however, you may want to add additional borders (e.g., 2" border of background fabric followed by 3" border of accent fabric or 3" piano key border of your assorted prints).
