Quilt Show Entry Rules, Guidelines and Procedures

Applies to Judged and Non-judged Quilts

Entry forms must be received no later than April 16, 2008

- Submit entry form (page 3) and waiver (page 4) as soon as possible, but no later than April 16, 2008.
- Use one form for each entry.
- Only one entry per category is eligible to be judged.
- Rank all of your entries (e.g., #1, #2, etc.). In the event we have too many entries, your notation will help us decide which ones to put in the show.
- The jury committee reserves the right to eliminate or divide any judged category. The jury committee reserves the right to move an entry to another category if strong indicators show it will be more fairly judged in that other category.
- Quilt tops must be made by a PQ member. For Group Quilts, at least one quilter must be a PQ member.
- Entries displayed in previous PQ “Quilting by the Bay” shows are ineligible for entry. It is permissible to enter quilts previously shown in other shows (e.g., San Mateo County Fair, Marin, PIQF, etc.).
- All entries **MUST** be accompanied by a photo of the entry. Label photo with your name, entry title and quilt size. Photos allow us to plan our show layout/floor plan prior to receiving your quilt.
- All quilts must have a 4” sleeve stitched to the top of the quilt back for displaying. Sleeve directions are available at meetings and on the web site.
- Quilts must be clean and free of animal hair.
- Fill out the paper label provided and sew to the lower right hand corner on the back of your quilt or inside your garment (so that it will not show when displayed). **No Pins Please.**
- Fill out and bring a claim check for each entry when delivering entries for show. A Quilt Show representative will provide an I.D. Number and sign the claim check to indicate the entry was received. This claim check is your receipt and will be required to reclaim your quilt at the end of the show.

All entries must be delivered between 2-4PM or 6-8PM

On Sunday, June 1, entries must be claimed between 5:30–6:30PM at the show site, Foster City Recreation Center.

No entry will be returned until the show is down and **NO** entry will be returned **WITHOUT** a claim check.

If you ask a friend to pick up your entry for you, be sure to give your friend the claim check!

Quick Checklist

At time of Entry Form Submission:

- Entry form completed for each entry
- Waiver signed and submitted
- Labeled photo of **Entry Front** attached
- \$6.50 check made out to Peninsula Quilters for each entry to be judged.

At time of Entry Delivery:

- 4” Sleeve sewn to quilt back
- Label filled out and sewn to entry
- Claim check filled out and presented at delivery
- Entry clean and free of animal hair

CATEGORIES FOR JUDGING

*Not all entries in the PQ show are judged.
The categories listed below only apply if you submit an entry for judging.*

All entries, judged or not: write measurements of quilt on back of photo and on entry form. A “quilt” is defined as a layered sandwich consisting of a fabric top, middle layer (batting) and backing, in which layers are held together by stitching (tied quilts and framed quilted objects cannot be judged).

QUILTED BY HAND

All hand-quilted quilts. Quilt may be any size, except for miniatures.

JOINT QUILT

If more than one person worked on your quilt, it must be in this category.

- A. Group: Top is pieced by more than one person (i.e., round robin, bee project, friendship quilt).
 - B. Pieced by one person and **quilted by another** person.
 1. **Small:** perimeter is 200 inches or less.
 2. **Large:** perimeter is greater than 200 inches.
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WALL HANGING

The quilt’s sole function is to hang on a wall. Quilt may be any size.

TRADITIONAL QUILT

The function of the quilt is to cover a bed, lap, couch/chair back, etc. There are three categories, depending on the quilt size, which is determined by the perimeter measurement (the total inches of all four sides of the quilt).

- Small:** perimeter is less than 200 inches.
 - Medium:** perimeter is between 200 and 300 inches.
 - Large:** perimeter is greater than 300 inches.

MINIATURE

Quilt is *scaled down* from the customary size while maintaining its proportions. Quilt sides must be 24 inches or less with a perimeter of 96 inches or less. Hand or machine quilted.

ART QUILT

Art quilts are expected to be completely original in design and to step beyond tradition in construction and appearance. Quilt may be any size.

WEARABLE ART

Clothing or fabric accessories (i.e., vests, dresses, ensembles, purses, etc.)

Label and Claim Check are required for EACH entry.
